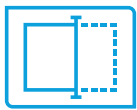




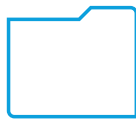
HP for Google Drive

An HP Workpath app

The HP for Google Drive app can be used to scan to and print from your Google Drive™ cloud account using the printer control panel. By providing a direct connection between the HP printer¹ and the Google Drive account, the HP for Google Drive app optimises workflows and worker efficiency with the following key features:



Scan directly to Google Drive and print or email directly from Google Drive in one integrated step using the printer control panel.



Quickly locate stored documents using enhanced search and filter capabilities.



Manage documents and apply document metadata directly from the control panel of any enabled HP printer.



Integrated document access and account sign-in steps eliminate additional time-consuming sign-on requirements and the extra step of downloading documents to a computer.

The HP for Google Drive app includes the following features:

- Sends notification emails
- Supports cloud SIO authentication from HP²
- File names are automatically date/time stamped
- Searchable documents
- Supported file resolutions for Google: 75 to 600 dpi
- File quality adjustment options for Google: Low, Medium, or High
- Scan-to document types: JPG or PDF
- Searchable OCR documents³
- File types supported: PDF, JPG, TXT, TIFF, and Microsoft[®] Office⁴

Before you can use HP for Google Drive, the following requirements need to be met:

- Active Google account
- HP for Google Drive app installed
- Workpath-compatible MFP⁵
- HP Command Center (HPCC) set up and configured⁶
- App client IDs already whitelisted
- Register swipe card⁷ with passcode OR account credentials through the installed authentication agent for use of cloud SIO²

¹ Not all MFPs may be compatible with Workpath apps. Not all apps may be available in all locations.

² For apps with Sign in Once (SIO) enabled and configured, set up the cloud SIO login.

³ Searchable OCR documents include CSV (OCR), HTML (OCR), PDF (OCR), PDF/A (OCR), RTF (OCR), Text (OCR), and Unicode Text (OCR) formats (on supported HP printers).

⁴ Supported Microsoft[®] Office files include *.doc, *.docx, *.xls, *.xlsx, *.ppt, *.pptx.

⁵ Selected models might require a DIMM accessory installed.

⁶ During HP Command Center (HPCC) setup and configuration, enable and configure the HP Workpath app(s) in HPCC, register your HP printer(s) with HPCC and enable the HP Workpath Link platform in HPCC.
